The entirety of the outstanding debt was forgiven and removed from the committee's reporting on the 2025 Year-End report, The committee's 2026 April Quarterly report included a number of disgorgements to the US Treasury for stale-dated checks. As a result of the disgorgements, the committee's bank account was cleared of all outstanding transactions, leaving the account balance wholly available for disposal. The committee proposes using the remaining funds to pay bank fees, pay legal fees related to closedown, pay compliance costs for records retention, records disposal and reporting services, and make charitable donations/political contributions. Upon approval, the committee will execute disbursements to dispose of the funds and subsequently file a zero-balance final report. Please inform the committee if the proposed plan is acceptable. **RE: Closing Out Campaign Finance Account.**


Dear Peter Nichols,
