SUBJECT: RECENT PULSE POLL KEVIN HERN WOULD LEAD EITHER KEVIN STITT OR STEPHANIE BICE IN A REPUBLICAN PRIMARY FOR U.S. SENATE.

DATE: MARCH 10, 2026

A Pulse Decision Science poll of n = 510 likely Republican Primary voters in Oklahoma, conducted March 7-9, 2026, shows that Kevin Hern would lead either Kevin Stitt or Stephanie Bice by double-digits in a primary match-up for the newly open U.S. Senate seat.

KEVIN HERN WOULD LEAD KEVIN STITT BY 12 POINTS IN A REPUBLICAN PRIMARY FOR U.S. SENATE.

- Hern would begin the campaign with 52% of the vote and a 12-point lead over Stitt.
- Stitt would have the support of 40% of primary voters and 8% would be undecided.

KEVIN HERN WOULD HAVE A DOUBLE-DIGIT LEAD OVER STEPHANIE BICE AS WELL.

- Hern would lead Bice with 49% of the vote.
- Bice begins with the support of 37% of primary voters and 14% are undecided in a Hern/Bice match-up.

Methodology

Pulse conducted a poll of n = 510 likely 2026 Republican primary voters in Oklahoma. Data was collected March 7-9, 2026, by live telephone interviews. Seventy percent (70%) of interviews were conducted to cell phones and 30% to landlines. The sample was selected from the Oklahoma voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, vote history, and educational attainment. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.4\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
